Whānau Direct - Whānau Direct provides an investment in essential resources of up to \$1,000 to support whānau in a moment that matters. The system has been enhanced to support our rapid response to COVID-19.

Whānau Ora Packs - Through the existing Whānau Ora network, we have distributed almost 35,000 Whānau Ora packs starting with hygiene and sanitation products. Our partners are also looking to enhance the packs with additional resource for whānau.

Kaiārahi - Kaiārahi have extended their reach to complete COVID-19 wellness checks with whānau. They continue to enable whānau resourcing through Whānau Direct and are also supporting the distribution of the Whānau Ora packs.
